\$1.5 Million	Building Exterior	Gift can be split into two gifts of \$750,000 shared by two different donors and/or a family and his/her company
\$250,000	Sky Garden Children's Library Large Conference Room	Interior atrium open to the sky Separated collection area with child-friendly furniture and computer stations Accommodates up to 65 people with multimedia capability
\$100,000	Homework Center Computer Lab Multi-Cultural Area Children's Story Cone Children's Garden	Tables, chairs, young adult books and computers in an acoustically separate room Computer lab which serves as a homework and classroom area for both youth and adults; available even when the main library is closed Special collection area which highlights the many cultures and ethnicities of Hercules Children's programming area for all ages Playful outdoor space wrapped by a perforated metal scrim
\$50,000	Non Fiction Area Fiction Area Periodicals Area Friends' Bookstore	Resource center with chairs and tables for quiet study Houses adult fiction, classics, and paperbacks Browse and read current magazines and newspapers in the library's living room Run by volunteers, proceeds benefit the library
